We are offering a four-weekend series on Classical Chinese Medicine that will explore each of the Channel Systems.

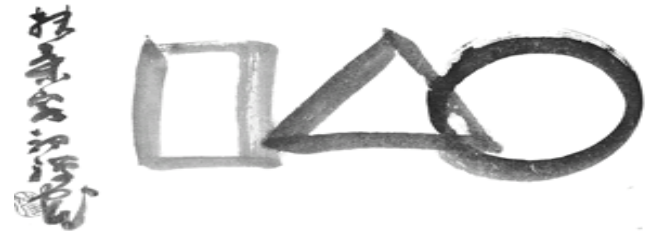
